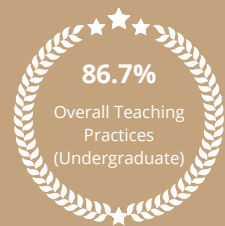
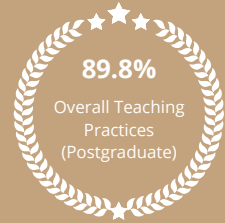
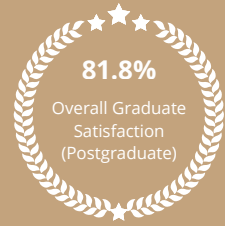

Exclusive 20% Onshore Regional Scholarship (Newcastle Campus) is available to new KOI **onshore** students enrolling at the Newcastle campus for the 2026 intakes. SELECTION PROCESS

KOI will conduct a merit-based review of each application. With the recommendation of a Selection Committee comprising of the admission manager, student services manager and VP Academic, KISS will be awarded to eligible students who have demonstrated academic excellence in their previous studies.

The decision of the KOI Committee will be final. The processing time is between 2-4 working days.

ONGOING CONDITIONS / REQUIREMENTS

- Students must maintain a 100% pass record for the scholarship to remain active.
- The scholarship is not transferable.
- Students must pay the required tuition fees by relevant due dates.
- The scholarship remains valid for students on an approved Leave of Absence for one trimester only.
- Scholarship applications will not be considered after the intake Census Date.
- Successful applicants must also agree to act as a student ambassador for the KOI Society and support promotional activities.
